	Possible Outcome	Who is at risk	Level of risk	Action Taken	New level of risk
Injury from the balls or darts falling on participants head / face / eyes	Cuts, Bruises, Bumps	Public/ users	Medium	Participants should only collect or throw the balls / darts when it is clear to do so. Any balls/ darts stuck to the board must be collected first before picking up any from the ground	Low
Injury to spectators or other participants	Cuts, Bruises, Bumps	Public / Users	Medium	No person should be standing / seated by the dartboard when the game is in play. Before use hirer / supervisor / operator must inform participants to stand a safe distance away.	Low
Inflatable blowing away or tipping over	Cuts, Bruises, Bumps, injuries	Users	High	Make sure unit is staked down, put down in wind or wind gusts of 24mph. Do not go above. Unit must be on grass	Low
Collisions with other participants	Cuts, bruises, bumps	Users	Medium	-Only 1 person to use the dartboard at anyone time ensuring it is clear before taking their go	Low
Unruly behaviour	Slips, falls, trips, bumps and bruises	Public	Medium	-Refusal to abide by the rules / guidance will result in participants being refused play or stopping the game completely	Low
User Safety	Injury	Public	Medium	Check and ensure no participant who suffers from back/neck/heart problems or is suffering from any side effects of drugs/alcohol/medical conditions. All Users should be aware of their own physical ability. Users to be instructed to queue behind or at the side of the person playing.	Low
