Entrapment / Drowning / incident	All	All Coaches and permit holders current and appropriate qualifications for the sessions that they will be running to be checked in advance of sessions. Ratios will be adhered to at all times. All people around the area will wear an appropriately fitted BA. First aid kit available on bank and on the site. Coaches currently FA qualified to be checked. Expected behaviour will be explained during briefing and consequences. If drowning is averted, casualty to be sent to hospital, secondary drowning. Lake and side to be checked before sessions start for unexpected hazards.	Correct permit holder / coach running sessions checked for each session. Numbers checked for each session. Illness	All	Appropriate clothing etc. to be checked to be suitable for conditions. Medical details checked before going on the water.
